The Gynaecological Oncology Department at the Royal Surrey NHS Foundation Trust and INTUITIVE Surgical take great pleasure in welcoming you to Our Second Annual Advanced Course in Robotic Gynaecological Surgery on the 23rd and 24th of October 2025. The advanced course is endorsed by the British and Irish Association of Robotic gynaecological Surgeons (BIARGS, The Society of European Robotic Gynaecological Surgery (SERGS) and hosted by Intuitive Surgical.

This 2-day advanced program is aimed at gynaecological surgeons with experience in robotic surgery who wish to progress to intermediate or advanced robotic gynaecological surgery. It aims to improve the knowledge and skills of surgeons in advanced robotic gynaecological surgery through demonstrations of decision-making, surgical tips and tricks, live surgery, complications management, and training pathways.
